 - In case the supply of breeds specified in the PR is not enough, other breeds not specified in the contract may be considered upon the recommendation of the Selection Team and the Technical Working Group of the PL 480 Goat Production Project for the Accelerated Hunger Mitigation Program to be approved by the procuring entity.
