MEMORANDUM ORDER

SUBJECT : ISSUANCE OF TEMPORARY WELFARE REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE FOR APPLICANTS FROM NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION (NCR)

Section 1 and 2 of R.A. No. 8485 *Animal Welfare Act of 1998* as amended by R.A. No. 10631, states that all animal facilities must be registered at the Bureau of Animal Industry.

Whereas, the Department of Agriculture Administrative Circular No. 4 Series of 2015 entitled "*Rules and Regulations on Registration of Animal Control Facility, Aviary, Cattery, Cattle Farm, Corral, Crocodile Farm, Gamefowl Farm, Goat Farm, Grooming Facility, Hog Farm, Kennel, Laboratory Animal Facility, Monkey Farm, Ostrich Farm, Pet Shop, Poultry Farm, Pound, Racetrack and Equestrian Establishment, Shelter, Slaughterhouse, Stock Farm, Stockyard, Stud Farm, Veterinary Clinic, Veterinary Hospital, Wildlife Rescue Center and Zoo including Circus/Carnival, Animal Show and other related Animal Facilities*", states the registration, standards and requirements, renewal of registration and the schedule of fees for all facilities.

Whereas, RA 11032 "Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Government Service Delivery Act of 2018" aims to simplify procedures to reduce red tape and expedite business and non-business related transactions in government.

In consideration of the foregoing challenges experienced by the stakeholders in complying with the laws and regulatory policies on top of Covid-19 pandemic, the BAI shall expedite the processing of Animal Welfare Registration Certificate.

Now therefore, the BAI shall issue Temporary Animal Welfare Registration Certificate, valid for three (3) months, to applicants who submitted complete documentary requirements but with pending animal facility inspection and those with facility that has undergone initial inspection but with minor deficiencies that needs immediate corrective measures.
