

SUBJECT

EXTENSION OF THE VALIDITY OF LICENSE-TO-OPERATE (LTO) AND CERTIFICATE OF FEED PRODUCT REGISTRATION (CFPR)

In view of the continuing restriction nationwide due to the current Covid -19 pandemic and the damages in certain regions brought about by the recent typhoon Odette which affect their communication facilities and other infrastructures, below are hereby implemented:

- 1. The validity of LTO issued for feed retailers, distributors, and dealers which expired last December 31, 2021 are hereby extended to March 31, 2022.
- 2. The validity of CFPR which expired last December 31, 2021 is hereby extended up to May 15, 2022.

Further, no surcharge will be imposed to applicant applying for renewal of LTO/CFPR during the extension period.
