SUBJECT

CONSIDERATION TO THE HEALTH AND WELFARE OF

LIVESTOCK, POULTRY, PETS AND OTHER NON-LIVESTOCK **EVACUATION** AND REHABILITATION ANIMALS ON

PROCEDURES

This has reference to the devastation left by the Typhoon "Odette" in the heavily hit areas of Northern Mindanao, Central Visayas, Leyte and Palawan.

In view of the above, the Bureau of Animal Industry, with mandate to implement the provisions of R.A. 8485/ R.A. 10631 Animal Welfare Act of 1998 to protect and promote animal health and welfare, strongly recommends the inclusion of means to rescue, temporary relocation, animal holding facility management, destocking of animals used for food, rehoming and rehabilitation of pets and other non-livestock animals in disaster management efforts of the government and non-government organizations (NGOs).
