SUBJECT : **TRANSSHIPMENT OF FROZEN MEAT AND POULTRY PRODUCTS IN THE SUBIC BAY FREEPORT ZONE**

DATE : **JUNE 22, 2020**

In order to facilitate the transshipment of frozen meat and poultry products to the Subic Bay Freeport Zone by Goldlink International Subic, Inc., you are hereby directed to take the following actions;

1. Once the company has submitted the list of foreign reefer containers and vessel arrival schedule:
 - 1.1 Coordinate with the Bureau of Customs and Subic Bay Metropolitan Authority on the transshipment. Advise them on the provisions of DA Memorandum Circular No.7 s.2017 which prohibits the opening or unloading of containers while at the transshipment port;
 - 1.2 Assign a Veterinary Quarantine Officer (VQO) to be responsible for managing the transshipment.
2. Upon arrival and during transit time:
 - 2.1 VQO shall ensure the integrity of the seal;
 - 2.2 The VQO shall tally each reefer container during its loading for the next port of call;
 - 2.3 Verify the company's compliance with the procedures set out in the notarized undertaking.
3. Submit transshipment monitoring and compliance report to the NVQSD Central Office.
