c. Delivery - The Contractor must notify the BAI Inspection Committee at least ten calendar (10) days in advance on the proposed date of delivery at specified locations. The inspection team shall have the right to reject any of the selected animals found to be not in good body and health condition resulting from the handling, transport and shipment, and/or replaced by another animal not in the final selection list. The Contractor shall replace the rejected animal(s) with another animal of the same breed and specifications.

The Contractor shall also replace any mortality within thirty (30) days post-acceptance

Payments – payments of the animals shall be made in the name of the Contractor after complying with the requirements, to wit:

- 1. Upon submission by the Supplier of an irrevocable letter of credit or bank guarantee issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank, advance payment for mobilization of ten percent (10%) of the contract amount shall be allowed and paid within sixty (60) calendar days from signing of the contract. The irrevocable letter of credit or bank guarantee must be equivalent to the contract price and accompanied by a claim for advance payment.
- 2. Subject to prior liquidation of the advance payment, seventy percent (70%) of the Contract Price shall be paid to the Contractor after the complete delivery and acceptance of:
 - Lot I. Goat: 24 head island-born, purebred Anglo Nubian bucks and 300 head island-born, purebred Anglo Nubian does;
 - Lot II Goat: 5 head island-born purebred Alpine bucks and 50 head island-born, purebred Alpine does;
 - Lot III Goat: 6 head island-born, purebred La Mancha bucks and 50 head island-born, purebred La Mancha does;
 - Lot IV Goat: 15 head island-born, purebred Saanen bucks and 185 head island-born, purebred Saanen does;

and upon presentation of original copies of the following documents:

Staggered on-farm delivery within two (2) years. The Contractor must notify the BAI Inspection Committee at least ten calendar (10) days in advance on the proposed date of delivery at specified locations (Annex B). The inspection team shall have the right to reject any of the selected animals found to be not in good body and health condition resulting from the handling, transport and shipment, and/or replaced by another animal not in the final selection list. The Contractor shall replace the rejected animal(s) with another animal of the same breed and specifications.

The Contractor shall also replace any mortality within **fifteen (15) days** post-acceptance

Payments – payments of the animals shall be made in the name of the Contractor after complying with the requirements, to wit:

- 1. Advance payment for mobilization of ten percent (10%) of the contract shall be allowed and paid within 60 calendar days from signing of contract upon submission by the Contractor of an irrevocable letter of credit or bank guarantee issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank. The irrevocable letter of credit or bank guarantee must be equivalent to the contract price and accompanied by a claim for advance payment.
- 2. Subject to prior liquidation of the claimed advance payment, the Contractor shall be paid through progressive billing, upon presentation of original copies of the following documents after each delivery and acceptance:
 - i. Delivery Receipt
 - ii. Supplier's Sales Invoice
 - iii. Packing List of the animals, pedigree certificates
 - iv. Laboratory test results and other related health documents (Annex A)
 - v. Animal Insurance Policy in favor of BAI
 - vi. Inspection and Acceptance Report
 - vii. Property Acknowledgement Report

The Contractor shall claim for payment after final acceptance for each delivery. Only the accepted animals shall be paid by the Procuring Entity.
