MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

SUBJECT: UPDATED REQUIREMENTS FOR ISSUANCE OF SHIPPING PERMIT FOR LOCAL MOVEMENT OF GAMEFOWLS DURING THE WORLD GAMEFOWL EXPO ON JANUARY 20, 21, AND 22, 2023

In the interest of public service and to provide guidance with regards to the issuance of Shipping Permit (SP) for the local movement of gamefowls during the WORLD GAMEFOWL EXPO 2023 on January 20 to 22, 2023, the following procedures shall be observed (SP):

1. All gamefowls that will be exhibited in the WORLD GAMEFOWL EXPO 2023 must be sourced from Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI)-registered Animal Facility and with a valid Animal Disease Monitoring Compliance Certificate (ADMCC);
2. The gamefowl must have negative Avian Influenza (AI) test result, Certificate of Free Status on Avian Influenza (CFSAI), sourced from AI free areas, consistent with DA Memorandum Circular No. 43 S. 2022 and MC 38 S. 2022, and registered in the Master List of the organization/farm;
3. Veterinary Health Certificate (VHC) and copy of the ADMCC shall be required for the online application of shipping permit. The printing of the approved permit shall be done at BAI booth;
4. Shipper/Owner must fill up the application form with required information: Full name, Complete Address of Destination and Landline or Mobile Number for traceability purposes;
5. Shipping Permit shall be issued only for gamefowl transported directly from the venue and shall be secured only from the BAI booth;
6. Upon arrival at the destination, shipper/owner must impose 30-day quarantine period for the gamefowl. Any disease manifestation that will be observed should be reported to the Regional Veterinary Quarantine Officer;
7. This Circular shall be valid only for shipping permits issued during the WORLD GAMEFOWL EXPO 2023.

Please be guided accordingly.

This Circular shall take effect immediately.
