SUBJECT : GUIDANCE FOR THE INTER-REGIONAL SHIPMENT OF LIVE SWINE AND ITS PRODUCTS FROM THE PROVINCES OF TARLAC AND PANGASINAN TO THE PROVINCE OF BENGUET AND BAGUIO CITY

DATE : MAY 14, 2020

The requirements and instructions for the inter-regional transport of live swine and its products from the provinces of Tarlac and Pangasinan to the province of Benguet and Baguio City shall follow the provisions of DA Administrative Order No. 05 Series of 2019, BAI Memorandum Circular No. 03 Series of 2020, BAI Memorandum Order Nos. 15 and 19 s.2020, to wit:

I. LIVE SWINE

1. Shipping Permit (SP)

- 1.1 ORIGINAL COPY of manual-issued Shipping Permit (SP) with signature and dry seal/stamp issued by the Regional Veterinary Quarantine Services (VQS) Office in Region III, San Fernando, Pampanga if from Tarlac or the Regional Veterinary Quarantine Services (VQS) Office in Region I, Lingsat, San Fernando, La Union if from Pangasinan.
- 1.2 Online-issued SP via <https://nvqsd.bai.gov.ph/nvqs> can be presented to the checkpoint using any gadgets such as but not limited to mobile phone, tablet, laptop etc.

2. Veterinary Health Certificate (VHC) – ORIGINAL COPY, single use

3. Certificate of Free Status (ASF)- Certified True Copy or Clear Photocopy

- Annex 1 or the Weekly Disease Monitoring Report SHALL NO LONGER be a documentary requirement

4. Livestock Handler's License - Certified True Copy or Clear Photocopy

5. Registration of Transport Carrier - Certified True Copy or Clear Photocopy

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II. UNCOOKED MEAT AND MEAT PRODUCTS

1. Shipping Permit (SP)

- 1.1 ORIGINAL COPY of manual-issued Shipping Permit (SP) with signature and dry seal/stamp issued by the Regional Veterinary Quarantine Services (VQS) Office in Region III, San Fernando, Pampanga if from Tarlac or the Regional Veterinary Quarantine Services (VQS) Office in Region I, Lingsat, San Fernando, La Union if from Pangasinan.
 - 1.2 Online-issued SP via <https://nvqsd.bai.gov.ph/nvqs> can be presented to the checkpoint using any gadgets such as but not limited to mobile phone, tablet, laptop etc.
2. **Meat Inspection Certificate (MIC)**- ORIGINAL COPY for **locally sourced** pork
 3. **Certificate of Meat Inspection (COMI)**- ORIGINAL COPY, for **imported** pork
 4. **License to Operate (LTO) and individual Certificate of Product Registration (CPR)**- Certified True Copy or Clear Copy, for **UNCOOKED, PROCESSED PORK**
 5. For **COOKED PROCESSED MEAT AND MEAT PRODUCTS** - License to Operate (LTO) and individual Certificate of Product Registration (CPR) from FDA. Shipping Permit from BAI is not required.
